



REVERSION EXAMPLE: NEPRHOLOGY AT NATIONAL HOSPITAL

- I. The Nephrology program at National Hospital has 7 positions in the Match:
 - 4 Nephrology–clinical track positions
 - 3 Nephrology–research track positions

- II. The fellowship program director chooses to revert, or donate, the following positions if they do not fill when the algorithm is processed:
 - 2 Nephrology-research track positions  to the Nephrology-clinical track

- III. When the algorithm is processed:
 - Nephrology-clinical track fills all four of its positions
 - Nephrology-research track fills 2 of its 3 positions
 -  The remaining 1 unfilled Nephrology-research track position reverts to the Nephrology-clinical track
 - Nephrology-clinical track fills the additional position reverted from the Nephrology-research track

Both the Nephrology-clinical and Nephrology-research tracks are considered "filled."

Note: If the position that was reverted from the Nephrology-research track to the Nephrology-clinical track had not filled, the Nephrology-clinical track would have been listed as unfilled in the *List of Unfilled Programs*.
