

Policy Tips/Reminders What Programs Need to Know

RECRUITMENT/REGISTRATION

Read the Match Participation Agreement

- Understand the "Dos and Dont's"
- Visit the Policies page on NRMP WWW for resources

Provide Complete, Timely, and Accurate Information

- Ensure policies, contracts, and onboarding processes are up-todate and clearly conveyed through the 45th day of training.
 - Required academic, education or prior training
 - Pre-employment drug testing and background check
 - Relevant licensure requirements and visas accepted at your institution.
- Must be able to demonstrate that all program policies / requirements were clearly communicated to interviewed applicants and that applicants acknowledge receipt of such information

Interview With Integrity

- Do not issue more interview invitations than the total number of available interview slots
- Allow no less than 48 hours for applicants to accept invitation
- Understand how your interview platform works and ensure communication with applicants is clear

RANKING

Review Applicant Credentials

- New information may be uploaded to the application; always verify you have up-to-date information from MSPE and applications prior to the Rank Order List Certification Deadline
- Re-evaluate ranking decisions if material changes occur

Respect Applicants' Confidentiality

- Do not ask applicants about applications sent, interviews accepted, or programs signaled
- Do not ask applicants about other specialties to which they may have applied
- Do not ask applicants about their ranking intentions
- Programs can ask about why the applicant is interested in their specific program, specialty, or region.

RESULTS/ONBOARDING

Honor the Binding Commitment

- Programs must train matched applicants unless NRMP grants a waiver
- Programs cannot seek an alternate candidate for training until a waiver has been approved



AT ALL TIMES

Know your Rights!

- Ranking information is confidential you are not obligated to share it with anyone
- Applicants must fully disclose the academic, professional, educational and legal experiences that could impact the program's decision to rank
- Behave in an ethical and professional manner
